

TWO NEW NAMES : *FROMEA SENEGALENSIS* AND *PTEROSPERMOPSIS KIESERI*

Recently JAIN AND MILLEPIED (1975) established two new species, viz. *Fromea elongata* and *Pterospermopsis concentricus* from the Upper Cretaceous of Senegal Basin, W. Africa. These two species are the later homonyms of *Fromea elongata* Beju (1971, p. 289) and *Pterospermopsis concentricus* Sin & Liu (1973 ; p. 19) respectively. Thus the specific names must be replaced. *Fromea senegalensis* nom. nov. (= *Fromea elongata* Jain & Millepied, 1975, p. 141, pl. 2, figs. 29-30) and *Pterospermopsis kieseri* nom. nov. (= *Pterospermopsis concentricus* Jain & Millepied, 1975, p. 155 ; pl. 6, fig. 87) are proposed here as replacements.
